One of these organizations is the Greater Laingsburg Recycling. This non profit organization is located on Roosevelt Row, between Grand River and McClintock. The drive typically takes place from 9am to 1pm, with about 10 to 15 volunteers at a time.

Those who volunteer help sort metal, newspapers and mixed plastic. However, things that are not accepted as recyclable are: motor oil, automotive fluid containers, polystyrene, plastic bags, fuel tanks, mylar, mirrors, drinking glasses, dishes, cookware, lightbulbs or perfume containers.
